We are at the Old Market which is the oldest part of Lodz, in the past it was the centre of the village Lodzia. At the market you can find information, such as “In what year was Lodz given city rights?” _____ To know the route direction you have to do the following calculations:

- 1) Multiply the middle digits of the year (for example 2x3)
- 2) Add all the digits of the year (for example 3+2)

Write the answer of 1) here-> __ / __ Write here the answer of 2)

Now you have the number of the street you are going to walk to.

Stand with your back towards the stone with the information about Lodz an look in front of you . You will see stairs, go along the stairs until you reach th Tourist Information Office. Somewhere near there is the sign with the name c the street you should go to.

We are at the Church of the Assumption of Our Blessed Mary – Rzymskokatolicka Parafii Wniebowzięcia Najświętszej Marii Panny. The hill the church is situated on, was called Górki Plebańskie (Priest’s Hills). Enter the church yard through the gate that you see.

On the right you will see the gravestone which is the relic of the cemetery . The church was built in 1897, on the area of the former wooden chapel.

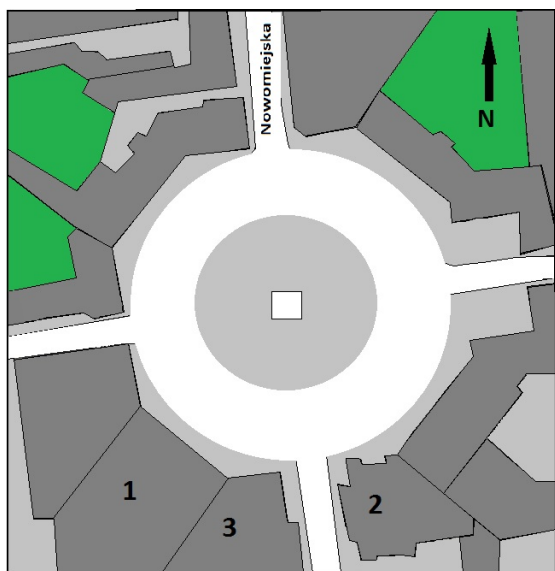
① *What style was the church built in? Put the answer on your answer sheet.*

During the 18th century, in that part of Lodz, Jews lived there. They were mainly merchants and fishermen. Herrings were very popular and they were sold in one,

specific place. To find this place go south in the direction of the stone you have found before.

Then go across the zebra crossing at the Analogia Restaurant (you have to cross Podrzeczna Street). On the left side of the park, in the pond area, look for Herring's Eye. (Oko Śledzia). Look down, and through the slots in the lid try to see The Lodka River (Łódka) by which our city was built. The river is hidden under the ground and flows under different parts of the city. ❷ Now find yellow and blue object and answer "What is it really?" Write your answer on the answer sheet.

Find Nowomiejska Street and go south until you reach New Market (Nowy Rynek) On your way there you will pass the mural. Stop there and count how many animals and eggs are on it. When you reach the market look around and count how many sides it has got. This is the place called New City in the past. The market has been called Freedom Square for hundred years. The shape of the Square is unique in Europe – it is the geometric figure called..... ❸ . Write your answer on the answer sheet. Then using the plan of the market write the names of the objects hidden behind the numbers

Do you remember how many animals you have seen at the mural at Nowomiejska Street? This is the number for where the next object is at. The street starts at the church.

You are at the place where the first hotel in Łódź was situated in the past. Go into the

yard, look around ❺ What flower comes to your mind when you see the patterns? Write its name on the answer sheet.

Now come to the street that trams go by, turn right and go into the direction of the decorative, corner building. At the crossing, turn right, go to „Biedronka” shop (Ladybird). Behind this shop there is the next object. The wooden church relocated from the Górki Plebańskie (Priest’s Hills). Read the information on the wall of the building and answer the following questions :
