What is to be a refugee? Refugee is a person who has left his native place because of persecution, wars, unrest, and other circumstances.

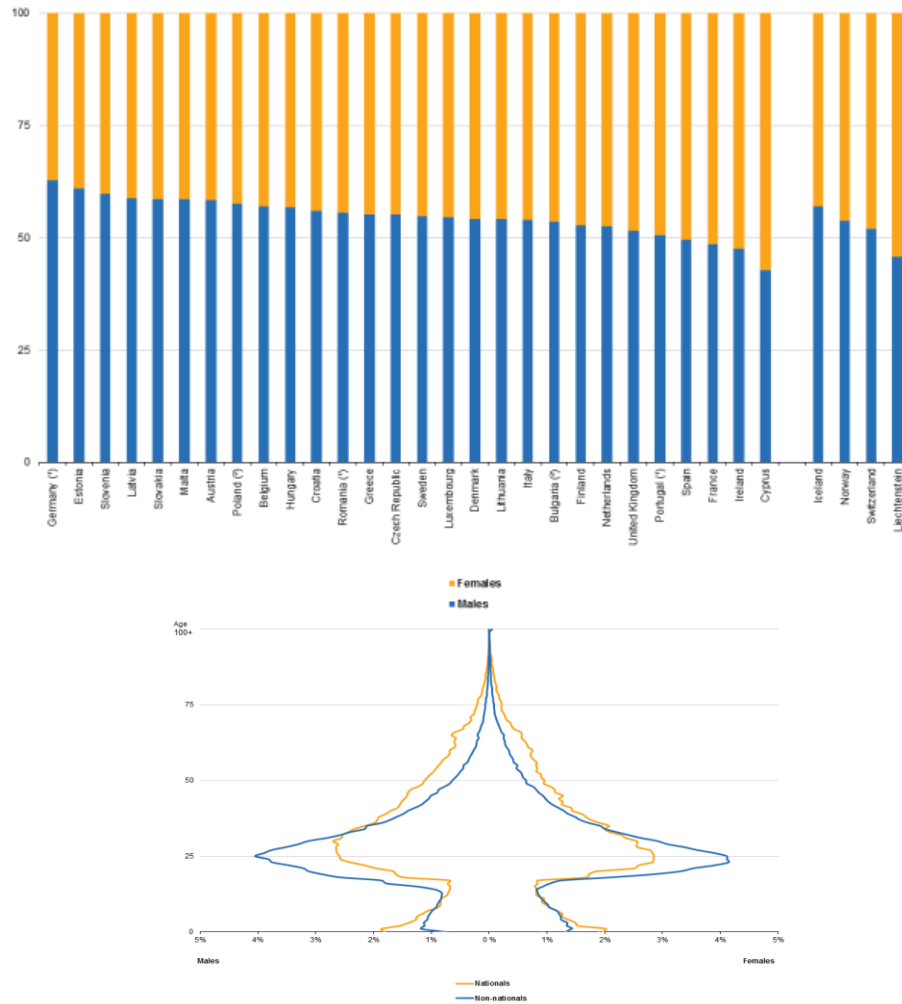


Europe faces the largest migration movement since the Second World War. More than 1 million refugees and migrants arrive in the EU, most of whom flee war and terrorism in Syria and other fragile countries. Seeking tranquility, people therefore resort to illegal crossing of foreign territory to reach their desired destination faster but not safer!

Illegally past the border of our country are being penalized for money. Almost 90% of refugees and migrants pay to organized criminal networks and human traffickers to pass them across borders. Providing food, water, and shelter to the needy puts enormous pressure on the resources of some countries. The EU has allocated more than € 10 billion of budget money to tackle the refugee crisis. Much of the effort is aimed at meeting the basic needs of arriving in the EU for clean water, food and shelter. But migrants still cross our border illegally as most of them as they pass through the country are supplied by carriers with drinking

water and food. Some are not lucky enough to find rivers and springs for drinking water.

According to the tables below, women and men over 30 years of age most often cross illegally.



The conclusion is that insecurity, fear and lawlessness are driving migrants to illegal action.
