A feedback poll from a learning event in Portugal on the project "Water in our World", Erasmus +

The survey, made after the learning event in Portugal among the participants, outlined the following trends and conclusions:

1. Before the learning event participants knew little about the host country
2. A great number of participants search information about Portugal and Lisbon
3. At the end of the learning event, participants are motivated to work on project activities
4. Participants make preliminary inquiries into the venue of the learning event
5. The participants are familiar with the activities of the project calendar – basically Logo competition, the stage Water in art and presentations of their country
6. The number of participating students in each partner school is less than 50
7. Participants have a positive attitude to participate in the learning event
8. Participants disseminate the objectives and results of the project
9. Activities during the learning event are good
10. Positive attitude of the hosts to the participants from the partner schools
11. Improving language competencies
12. Positive influence on the attitude of the participants in the project towards foreign cultures and traditions, positive change in attitudes towards tolerance and sharing of cultural values
13. The activities carried out through work on the stages of the project increase the motivation of student for learning and the motivation to work among teachers
14. Travlling is tiring but cofortable

Comments and recommendations:

- Too many expenses – high budget of the learning event
- More careful and precise time planning of the learning trips and activities
